**A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR**

**Summer Musings**

For many of us, summer is a time to take a break from some of our responsibilities and take a rest and also take account of what has happened the year before and where we will be in the future. If you are one of the ones given the time to have a break this summer, I encourage you to indeed rest this summer as an opportunity to regroup and evaluate. During the summertime at Cornerstone, your pastor, church staff, and leaders continue to nurture the life and worship of our congregation as we dream and plan ministries for the future. As your pastor, summer often gives me an opportunity to plan out the preaching schedule and the Christian Education plan for the regular year. For me, this is a kind of Sabbath. This summer hasn't had as much of that opportunity as I would have liked but I do so enjoy the summer sun and the breeze that comes along every once in a while. A friend of mine encourages her congregation to pick up a daily spiritual practice if summer allows for a slightly more flexible schedule. If you do pick up a spiritual practice, consider how it might nurture your own growth in faith. It might be something simple, like reading scripture or another inspiring book at the beginning or the end of the day. It might be taking a short, contemplative walk after dinner. It might be simply taking a moment each day to be still and know God. Establishing helpful habits takes thought, but the rewards of a daily practice are reflected in all aspects of our lives. If your summer travels lead you to visit another community of faith, note the similarities and differences in their worship and fellowship. Bring back a bulletin (order of worship) if you like, and share wisdom and ideas from other communities with our church staff and our elder and deacon team.

Please know I pray for each of you each day and ask the Lord to bless all of us richly at Cornerstone as we seek to be faithful in service and worship to Christ our Lord in Jackson and beyond.



## Premiere of *Destiny's Bridge*

Two River Theater in Red Bank, NJ

This is a feature film about the homeless encampment in Lakewood, NJ where, for the last seven years, 115 souls have found community under the wings of Minister Steven Brigham in the pine barrens of Ocean County, NJ. This film tells their story of struggle to survive and have a roof over their heads.

It also introduces the ideas that the homeless themselves have for taking things into their own hands and building a community where they can live with dignity and connect to services and counsel which will enable them to become self-sufficient and productive members of society, once again. The community will be called *Destiny's Bridge* - a home for the homeless, and the film is the first step towards raising the funds that will be needed to establish it. A non profit organization with a board has been formed to carry this idea to fruition.




### Church Ladies


### Financial Report for July


