A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Spring is Here and Winter is Past

In this part of the country, we have had a challenging winter with snow, ice, and cold temperatures. Storm after storm descended upon us and for many it proved a test of our souls to keep hopeful for Spring. In the midst of the weather and the storms, the cold and ice seem to bare the truth behind difficulties each is struggling with in day to day life. Some are dealing with troubled relationships, job losses or demands which have led to imbalanced lives, some are grieving the one they loved too much to lose, and still others suffer from illnesses of body or mind that seem to monopolize all energy and strength. Perhaps we could say that many feel as if they have been buried in frozen ground.

If we remember back to what is told to us through Ash Wednesday we remember that in Genesis it says that God took from the earth and breathed life into the dust and formed humanity as we know it. And, as we are aware of our own mortality we also know that to dust we shall return. This imagery of being buried in frozen ground could be the challenge that we face in hoping for new life and for spring.

The Easter Story teaches us a sacred understanding of what it means to be buried and to find new life. Jesus says in John 12:24: "Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds." We have the promise that as we join Jesus in death, we join him in new life. We are given an opportunity through Jesus' life, sacrifice, death, and life to know the promise of God that eternal life is the gift. In Christ, we are able to come up from being buried under frozen ground to find new life and second chances for all areas of our lives. Spring is Here in the message and Good News of The Gospel and Winter is Past. Come and journey with us into God's greatest gift - LIFE! Jesus is not dead but He is RISEN!

I hope you will plan to be with us for our services leading up to Easter. We will have Palm Sunday on April 13 and observe Maundy Thursday with Jackson United Methodist on Thursday, April 17 at 7 PM and Easter will be at 10 AM at Christa McAuliffe. We are also invited to attend Good Friday Service at Presbyterian Church of Lawrenceville. (see notice later in the newsletter).

My friends I am blessed to be your pastor and to have survived the winter with you and look forward to celebrating the thawing and the arrival of Spring! Jesus Christ loves us and breaks us free from frozen ground. Halleluiah! Amen!







All Women Welcome!



The Adult Book Study meets on Mondays and has started a new study on the book *Know Doubt: The Importance of Embracing Uncertainty in Your Faith* by John Ortberg.

This group meets at 6:30 PM at the home of Bob & Laurie Wegner. All adults are encouraged and welcome! Description: Without a doubt Ever 'stumbled' in your faith? Wrestled with uncertainty? Wondered if you're a true believer? If the answer is yes to any of these questions---and it probably is---you have reason to celebrate. In this candid book based on his own struggle with doubt, John Ortberg traces the line between belief and unbelief and finds that it's less a dividing line between hostile camps than a razor's edge that

runs through every soul. His findings point toward the relief of being totally honest. Doubt ... Questions ... Honest faith ... Outrageous hope ... It's a chain reaction that can actually strengthen our relationship with God, and that, says Ortberg, is cause for celebration.

Per Capita

Officially "Per capita is an opportunity for all members of the Presbyterian church through the governing bodies to participate equally, responsibly, and interdependently by sharing the cost of coordination and evaluation of mission; and of performing ecclesiastical, legislative, and judicial functions that identify a Reformed Church, while at the same time strengthening the sense of community among all Presbyterians" (GA Minutes, Part I, 1995). In essence: "Per capita is a set amount of money (apportionment) per member that congregations pay to the larger Presbyterian Church (USA). Every Presbyterian shares in the benefit of the PC (USA)'s system of government, so every Presbyterian is asked to share the expenses associated with coordinating and performing the functions of that system."

The annual per capita amount is a combined request from a congregation's Presbytery, Synod, and the General Assembly. The 2013 General Assembly budget determines the individual capita rate that provides:

- Expenses for bringing commissioners and advisory delegates to a General Assembly -The cost of bringing together Presbytery and Synod church leaders for training events, as well as those who serve on permanent GA committees -Tools to develop and administer ordination exams Travel expenses of the Moderator and Vice Moderator of the GA -The call system and other work that helps all Presbyterians discern their vocation
- Information, advice, and council to Presbyteries and pastors about immigration issues -The Presbyterian Historical Society -The production and distribution of the Book of Order, Book of Confessions, and other GA publications.

A Presbyterian presence at ecumenical groups and gatherings in the United States and worldwide. The 2014 total per capita is \$35.20 per member. Please give as you are able and consider sponsoring someone else who might not have the means at the moment. Blessings!
