A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR



Welcome to Advent! Many would agree this is one of the busiest times of the year and is often stressful. It is also one of the holiest times of the year. As Christians we live life in tension between what the world promises and the mystery of a call to grow deeper in faith with Jesus. The birth of Jesus, that we celebrate at Christmas each year is when God took on human form and entered into our world to live among us. The Bible teaches that life is lived in the tension between the frailty of human existence and God's divine plan for our lives. In my studies over the years I am fascinated to understand that the Incarnation, where Jesus is both human and divine guides us through our own tension between the world around us and God's Kingdom that is here but not fully realized. As we venture through Advent, we see the tension between choosing to be holy in the midst of our busyness and to be busy in the midst of our holiness.

We need God's grace because we will inevitably stumble and fall in the tension. We find that we need God's grace in order to live into the sacred without getting pulled by the temptation of worldly things. My challenge to you during this Advent and Christmas season is to use every opportunity you receive, to invite God to guide you in the tension. Let your mind be in prayer and conversation with God. Your sense of the sacredness of ordinary life will grow in your heart and mind, making this holy season of the year even more powerful and meaningful for you. I pray for each of you and ask God to keep you in the palm of His Hand.

What Is the Christmas Joy Offering?



A cherished Presbyterian tradition since the 1930s, the Christmas Joy Offering is one of the four special offerings designated by the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). Because Advent and Christmas shine a light not only on our world's greatest hope but also on our world's greatest need, the PC(USA) provides this timely opportunity for congregations to support causes specifically designed to bring "good news of great joy" (Luke 2:10) to the poor in circumstance or spirit. Alongside the message of promise and fulfillment in Luke's Gospel, we also hear the clear call to God's people to respond in faith as Christ calls us: "From everyone to whom much has been given, much will be required; and from the one to whom much has been entrusted,

even more will be demanded" (Luke 12:48).

Undesignated gifts to the Christmas Joy Offering will be distributed equally to the Assistance Program of the Board of Pensions and to support student scholarships at Presbyterian-related racial ethnic schools and colleges.

Cornerstone will be accepting the Joy Offering donations throughout the month of December with a special collection on December 23rd and 24th. Envelopes are available if needed.




Church Ladies
