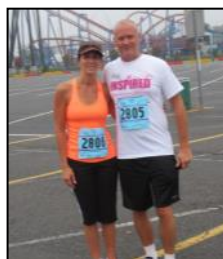
Welcome to Darby June Thompson, new granddaughter to Bob & Laurie Wegner, born on October 20, 2013!

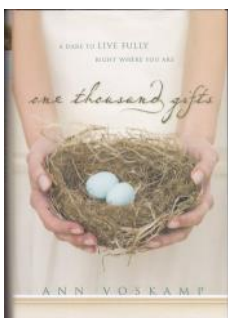
Church Ladies

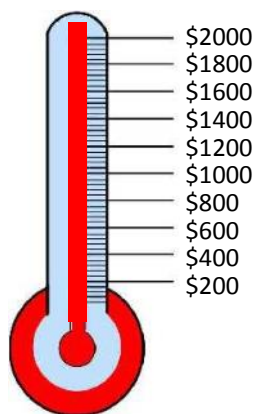
Financial Report for October

- Tithes/offerings* = \$6098
(Weekly: 10/6 = \$1691, 10/13 = \$1556, 10/20 = \$1565, 10/27 = \$1286)
- Per Capita offering = \$40
- Foundation Fund = \$50 (Shop Rite)
- Gifts from other churches = \$2500 (Presbyterian Church of Toms River)
- Special Offerings = \$465 (Samaritan's Purse) + \$135 (Prison Ministry)

Per Capita

To provide support for Monmouth Presbytery, Northeast Synod and General Assembly, our church is asked to pay "dues" to the Presbytery each year that is equal to \$35 per member. 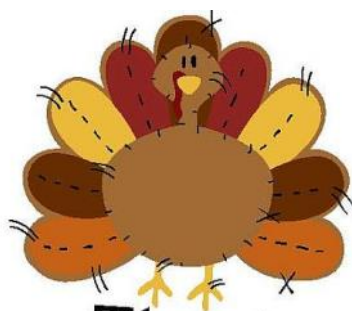

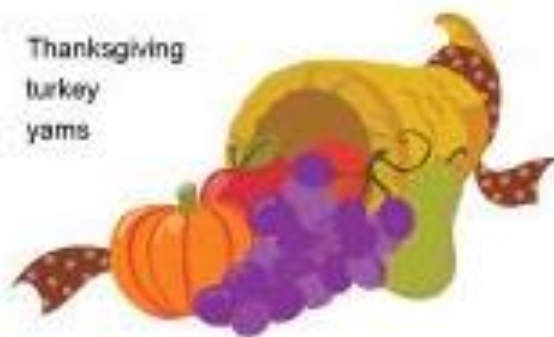
