Children’s Church

Jesus’ words in Mark 10:14 say, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.” In the midst of a consuming ministry to adults, Jesus regularly ministered to children. The future of the church depends on effective ministry with children today. Cornerstone values and loves our children and seeks to equip them for a relationship with Christ by guiding them to a right knowledge of Scripture and Worship. Beginning October 2 during the 10 AM worship, children are encouraged to stay in worship the whole time. If younger children are restless, they are invited to attend Children’s Church. All children age 8 and above are asked to stay for the entire worship service. Adult volunteers are needed to help with Children’s Church, a very important ministry. During Children’s Church, the younger children will have a bulletin, will listen and learn to sing Christian music, they will hear a Bible lesson, and they will worship in an environment that is appropriate to their age. Volunteers are needed to assist one Sunday, multiple Sundays, or all the time with Children’s Church. The curriculum will be easy to follow and use. If you would like to volunteer to assist with this important ministry, please let Pastor Courtney know.

STARTS OCTOBER 2nd at 8:00 a.m.—FIRST CLASS IS FREE!

What: We will be offering again this year the Financial Peace University, created by Dave Ramsey. If you want to learn how to handle your finances according to Biblical Principles, if you want to restore hope to your life, if you want to put your personal finances in order and in perspective, and reenergize spiritually yourself and your family in the process, you will want to participate in this course

Who Could Benefit from this course: Even though this is a course that shows participants what the bible says about finances, the simple principles that it teaches can help everybody. More than a million families have taken this course.

- Anyone who would like to deepen their relationship with God by learning the Biblical principles that apply to finances.
- Anyone that feels that money, debt, and credit cards control their life; anyone that feels that their life does not belong to them; anyone that wants to learn how to control their money

Payment is due by the first class. However, if this would be difficult for you, please speak to us.

- A hardcover workbook that will help you apply the principles learned in class to your specific situation.
- Audio CDs of the dvds that that you watched in class.
- An envelope system to help with your budget
- Access to the Dave Ramsey web site that will supplement and go deeper into the topics covered. I recommend the My Total Money Makeover, the Dave Ramsey radio shows with the best Questions and answers all organized in an easy way to find, and several online tools such as a debt snowball calculator, and a budget tool.

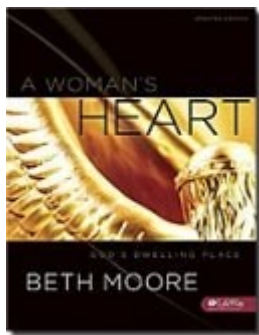
