"I am currently entering my second year at Princeton Theological Seminary, after working this summer as a Chaplain at a trauma hospital in Pennsylvania. Prior to attending Seminary in New Jersey, I spent most of my life in the Pacific Northwest, where my family is from. I graduated from George Fox University in Portland, OR in 2009 with a degree in Business and Communication. After working in marketing for a year for a start-up company, I had a major change of vocational call and began pursuing a long-held passion for ministry and missions. In 2010 I moved to Guatemala for a couple months to work at an orphanage, before returning to Spokane, WA to work at a crisis nursery with 0-6 year olds in crisis situations. 


