
### Per Capita


To provide support for Monmouth Presbytery, Northeast Synod and General Assembly, our church is asked to pay "dues" to the Presbytery **each year** that is equal to \$35 per member. Therefore, we are asking *each member* to give a special offering of \$35 per year to help us cover this expense. This is what we call the per-capita. In 2013, we had a goal of collecting \$2000 in per-capita funds, and we exceeded this goal! It's now time to start collecting for 2014—please place your per-capita offering in the basket on Sunday (mark it as "per-capita") at your earliest convenience. Thank you.

### **Financial Report for December**
