

Progress at Harmony! An update from Bruce Thompson

The month of June will be an exciting one for Cornerstone's renovation of the Harmony Road church. The biggest surprise was the discovery



of the stained glass window that had been installed behind the altar and had been removed for safe keeping (photo on left). A big thanks to



building) and ducting for the additions will be done as well.

By the end of June, the additions should near completion except for finishing (painting, etc.) which the congregation will provide. The HVAC system will be installed making working inside more accommodating. We are currently seeking bids to paint the ceiling and the painting of the remainder of the sanctuary is close to 75% completed. The second means of egress will also be completed by mid-June and the handicap ramp will be built shortly thereafter. We have contracted to have the siding

replaced which should be completed by the end of July. We will also be seeking bids for some joist work that is needed in the basement. The remainder of the renovations are primarily outside and regard installation of a septic system, clearing of the parking areas and the installation of the gravel as well as the installation of the handicap parking. Storm window have been purchased for most of the stained glass windows but not for the windows by the altar. We were able to save the stained glass in the vestibule and they will be installed in the front and sides of the additions at the front of the church.



Sundays in the Summer



Rehearsals are low key and fun! We are always looking for new members and hope that you will prayerfully consider joining this awesome group of singers. Singing is another way that we can pray.






ADULT BIBLE STUDY—Monday Evenings 6:30-8:00 PM



Per Capita


