We received word just before Christmas that our boxes were delivered to children in Uganda and Hondurus!




We had a fun time seeing the Newark Boys Chorus on December 9th, with a great lunch afterwards!
















### The Cornerstone Choir rehearses before worship on Sundays at 9:00 AM.


