
### **New Members Class**

Work to be done:

- 1) Install all remaining storm windows
- 2) Repair the pews that need to be reconnected.
- 3) If possible install a hand rail at the steps to the altar.
- 4) Reinstall lamps on the front and rear walls.
- 5) Continue to clean out trailer.
- 6) Paint and scrape window frames as needed and available; also touch up vestibule.
- 7) Install mirror in rest room.
- 8) Replace bad battery in emergency light fixture.
- 9) Evaluate necessary landscaping.
- 10) Mark off area for tree removal for parking lot.






### The Fifteen Funniest Church Bulletin Bloopers!
