A Message from Pastor Tory

As I write to you the Groundhog has not seen his shadow, which means two things. One, spring will come early! Which means work on Harmony Road will get back underway sooner. Two, it means I am late giving my newsletter to Elizabeth. Thank goodness Elizabeth has the patience of a saint, she is the best.

During February, in the Christian church, we begin the season called Lent. On February 10th, Ash Wednesday Lent begins and continues for forty days. Lent is a time of reflection and prayer. This Lent I am personally encouraging you to sign up for our Lenten Bible Study. We are going to use the series called "Glory Days". Glory Days is written by Max Lucado who is an accessible yet brilliant Christian writer and preacher. The book Glory Day, living your promised land now, looks at the book of Joshua. Max helps us wrestle with the question, "Why did God's chosen people wander 40 years in the wilderness and then suddenly have everything change as they entered the Promised Land." Through this video based discussion lead by Max we discover some insights into how this miracle came to be. Together over the six sessions we will discuss how God brings us out of the difficulties of our past, if we are able to let go of our "can't do" attitude. We, like the Israelites, must choose to believe in God who fulfills promises. That the land flowing with milk and honey is calling. Glory Days for you and I are for the taking. Yet, too often as miserable as we might be in our wilderness it is what we know. To enter "Jericho" seems too risky. Perhaps your Jericho is a new job because the job your in is a dead end. Maybe your marriage has become like week old bread, a little stale. Yet who has the time to work on it, nobody wants to rock the boat. Perhaps there is a dream for your life not yet realized. A dream that is quickly fading as years past. Max, in his book, reveals the good news we were made for Glory Days. Max invites us to read the words below, this holy declaration, to let it settle deep into our hearts as we walk forward into God's will for our lives.

These days are Glory days. My past is past, my future is bright, God's promises are true and his word is sure. With God as my helper, I will be all he wants me to be,

Do all he wants me to do, and receive all he wants me to receive. These are the Glory Days.

I hope each of you will prayerfully consider joining one of our Bible Study opportunities. As we read his book and watch the video I know we will grow in our faith as well as come closer to one another as a church family. Three different sessions will be offered—please see page 10 for details.


All items should be clean and in reasonably good shape. The clothes are not shredded for rags and are intended to be



Lenten Study "Glory Days" by Max Lucado



Cornerstone will be holding a special Bible Study throughout Lent that we encourage the entire congregation to participate in. The six -week study is by Max Lucado and is called "Glory Days."

Description: Often we go through situations where challenge seems so much greater than our strength. We can find hope and inspiration from the story of Joshua. God had called Joshua to take over from Moses and lead the Israelites into a paradigm shift from wilderness wandering to promise-believing.

God had a Promised Land in store for them, but they had to grasp that reality, change their mindsets, and take action to receive it. The same is true for us today. God is telling us that our best days—our "glory days"—are still ahead of us. We only need to grasp that truth and live in faith to realize this promise.




