A Message from Reverend Pruner

Cornerstone Church will be on the move as we join with other congregations in the Villages in Partnership Water Walk. Many of our youth and adults will walk to continue the change we are making WITH the Villages in Malawi. Many years ago, I was blessed to travel to Malawi and witnessed firsthand the poverty that the people endure. In Malawi there are 18.5 million people and the annual income is just \$650 per person. Approximately half of the population is severely underweight leaving them vulnerable to disease. One of the most heartbreaking facts is that there are one million children who are orphans. These facts are difficult for us to imagine. We are so blessed and too often take for granted the blessings we have.

The Water Walk is one small way we can connect with what a day in the life of a Malawian is like. Every day the women and children walk miles just to get clean water. Then they carry a bucket on their heads filled with water weighing about 20lbs back to their village. Through our partnership with many of the villages there are now wells with clean water. The villagers work to dig and prepare for the well equipment that VIP provides. What a celebration there is when the water flows!

The woman I met when I was in Malawi seemed to beam with the Spirit of the Lord. These women had been gathering water for their families their entire lives Most had lost children and husbands. Yet, there was never any time to grieve, water had to be fetched and dinner made over open fires. *(continued)*






Team Harmony is walking for Sijaya Makawa.
