

A Message from Reverend Pruner

One of the annual Christmas television specials that was always a favorite of mind was the Charlie Brown Christmas. You may remember that Charlie Brown is the director of the Christmas play and hunts for the perfect tree, and Linus expounds on the true meaning of Christmas.

What I didn't know until very recently was when the special was first shown, CBS was concerned that the use of actual Bible quotes in the special would turn off viewers. Imagine the Bible encroaching into a Christmas special! It seems absurd, but true.



Even back in 1965 there was a force to take "Christ" out of "Christmas". But Peanuts creator Charles Schulz was insistent that the actual quotes from the Bible would be used. So, Linus recites from the gospel of Luke, telling the same story we read from during Advent as we prepare hearts for Christmas. Something I have noticed in the show is the security blanket that Linus is so attached to, he lets go of when he tells the story of Jesus' birth.

And why shouldn't he? We find here is our security and our peace. As we approach the manger, we discover our hope and experience Good News of Great Joy!!! God has come into our world in the babe of Bethlehem. Why shouldn't we lift our voices with songs of joy? Something very special happened in our world two thousand years ago. A babe was born to a humble couple, a baby who makes it possible for us to know and to love God. It doesn't get any better than that. No gift has ever compared to the greatest gift of all. May your family experience the wonder and joy of Christmas through the witnesses from the Gospel of Luke.




The Master's Clowns December 8, 2019 10:00 AM





A NEW STUDY STARTING IN 2020!

The Tuesday morning Women's Bible Study will meet on Tuesday, January 7th at 10:30 AM at Harmony House to begin a 6-week study of *Christianity, Cults, and Religions*. All women are welcome to attend! Talk to Elizabeth about getting a study guide.



The *Christianity, Cults & Religions* DVD-based study helps Christians know what they believe and why. By comparing Christianity with groups such as Mormons and Jehovah's Witnesses, people have a better grasp about what the Bible says about who Jesus is and the message of the Gospel. This six session study simply explains the history, background, and beliefs of the most common world religions and cultic groups: Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, Mormonism, Jehovah's Witnesses and other groups.


Thank you to our Director of Music, Doreen Laskiewicz, and the Cornerstone RINGERS AND SINGERS for providing a joyful noise during worship!
