

Per Capita Offering for 2020

Our Per Capita Offering is now being collected for 2020. Per capita is an amount of money per member (this year, \$42.00) that our congregation pays to our larger Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The amount not given by the members must be covered by our general budget, taking away from other work and ministry of Cornerstone.

The Per Capita Offering is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. It enables us to work with other Presbyterian churches in our presbytery and across the country. When we give our offering, it allows us to work with other churches to further the mission of Jesus Christ around the world. Per Capita also funds the preparation, administration, and grading of standard ordination examinations for seminary students. Helping to prepare future ministers to faithfully answer their call from God. As Presbyterians, we believe that we need each other as we work together to and discern the mind of Christ for the PC (USA).

We encourage all members to pay your share of \$42.00 per member, even if it is made in small increments throughout the year. By contributing your portion of per capita, you will free up dollars in our regular budget for the work of our congregation in this community. We hope you will make this contribution at your earliest convenience. Together is how we have the greatest impact!






Three kings brought gifts to baby Jesus as we celebrated Epiphany on January 5th








Our first team in 2012!

After many consultations, estimates, and discussions, the process is well underway and we expect to be back in Harmony House for Sunday School, Youth Group, and other activities this month!


