A Message from Reverend Pruner

Cornerstone Church Friends,

March 15th was the last time we were able to join together for worship in the Sanctuary and to say the words "I miss you" are just not strong enough! These past seven weeks have been challenging in so many ways. I feel confident that your hearts have broken hearing of the suffering of so many of our friends and neighbors, just as mine has. In the midst of this crisis however, has emerged many blessings. We have been blessed by the countless who continue to care for us. The doctors, nurses, health care workers, first responders, police, mail carriers, grocery workers, pharmacy workers, gas stations and convenience store workers. We have also been blessed with technology that has allowed us to stay connected.

When life is forced onto a new path, like the path we are on now, we can find ourselves concentrating on the negatives. We can become overwhelmingly frightened and stressed out. Although we may feel like we are the first to walk a difficult path, history reveals we are not. The Bible illustrates how the faithful of the past also struggled. They teach us how we can survive and in many ways thrive. This is why I will be preaching a sermon series entitled, "Prayer, the Greatest Wireless Connection." Each week we will learn and begin to commit to memory one verse of psalm 23. We will focus on the need for prayer every day, on good days and tough days. When the psalmist was spiraling down into despair, he went in prayer to "the sanctuary of God; then I understand "(Psalm 73:17). Through our conversations with God we come to a deeper understanding of life and a closer relationship with the Lord who knows us better than we know ourselves. When we put our focus on God's word and follow with meditation and prayer we are led to a life-giving vision. In Timothy Keller's book on pray he writes, "Through prayer, which brings heaven into the ordinary, we see the world differently, even in the most menial and trivial tasks. Prayer changes us." 

No Stigma Network, Inc.



One of our elders, Linda VanMelis, is on the Board of an organization called No Stigma Network (NSN), a nonprofit that offers support to young adults, ages 18-39, with mental health challenges. During this time of quarantine, they are offering Zoom support meetings several times a week. There is an all-men's group, sign language instruction and practice, and social discussion groups. Meetings are geared to the needs of young adults who battle the challenges of depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, PTSD, OCD, and high-functioning autism (Asperger's).

Per Capita Offering for 2020

Our Per Capita Offering is now being collected for 2020. Per capita is an amount of money per member (this year, \$40.00) that our congregation pays to our larger Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The amount not given by the members must be covered by our general budget. The total amount due is over \$4,000, last year approximately half was paid out of the operating budget, taking away from the ministry of Cornerstone.

The Per Capita Offering is one way we work together with Presbyterians from other Presbyterian churches in our presbytery and across the country. When we give our offering, it allows us to work with other churches to further the mission of Jesus Christ around the world. One great example of how Per Capita supports the local church ministry is through the funding of the preparation, administration, and grading of standard ordination examinations for seminary students. This is one way we help to prepare future ministers to faithfully answer their call from God. As Presbyterians, we believe that we need each other as we work together to and discern the mind of Christ for the PC (USA).

We encourage all members to pay your share of \$40.00 per member, even if it is made in small increments throughout the year. By contributing your portion of per capita, you will free up funds in our operating budget for the work of our congregation in this community. We hope you will make this contribution at your earliest convenience. Together is how we have the greatest impact!

Generosity Abounds!


On behalf of the Session I want to thank you so much for your generosity. So many of you have been able to keep up with you tithes and offerings. We recognize that some of you have been laid off, we want to assure you that the church understands and does not want you to worry. God always provides. 








Women's Tuesday Morning Bible Study Tuesdays, 10:30 AM


The Faithful: Heroes from the Old Testament


